

TOWNSHIP OF EAST HAWKESBURY

PUBLIC MEETING

HELD FEBRUARY 8, 2010 AT 7:30 P.M.

The members of Council, Township of East Hawkesbury, held a **Public Meeting** on Monday, February 8th, 2010 at 7:30 p.m., in the Council Chamber at St-Eugène.

PRESENT:

Robert Kirby, Mayor, Richard Sauvé, Deputy Mayor; Councillors Linda Séguin, Gabriel Dussault and Luc Lalonde and Clerk Linda Rozon.

Application to be heard:

Daniel Renaud
Part Lot 1, Concession 6

1. The meeting is declared open at 7:30 p.m. by the Chairman
2. As required under the Planning Act, the Clerk then makes the following public statements:

"If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submission to the Township of East Hawkesbury before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Township of East Hawkesbury to the Ontario Municipal Board also, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so."

3. At the request of the Chairman, the Clerk then explains the purpose and reasons for the proposed amendment, and copies of proposed amendment are available to the public.
4. The Chairman explains that this meeting is held to discuss a proposed amendment to the Township of East Hawkesbury Zoning By-Law No. 92-50 to change the zone designation of a parcel of land in order to allow for the construction of a storage building for industrial vehicles and equipment. The minimum building height will be increased and the accessory building regulations will be modified to permit the construction of this building prior to construction of a principle permitted use.
5. The Chairman then asks if anyone present wishes to make an oral or written objection on the proposed amendment.

Mr. & Mrs George Schubert and Mr. Daniel Renaud are present.

- * No written or oral **objection** is made at this time and no written or oral **objection** was received prior to meeting.
- * A copy of the amendment proposed for the new Zoning By-Law had been remitted to each member to peruse and this is discussed in detail.

6. The Chairman then states that any person who further notice of the passing of the by-law should give their name and address to the clerk prior to leaving the meeting, to be written on sheet provided.

The Chairman then states that a Notice of Adoption of the proposed by-law will be sent by prepaid mail to the persons concerned in this application and to agencies, and that the **last date for filing a notice of appeal of the by-law will be March 2, 2010**, AND THAT information is available regarding the procedures for the filing of an appeal and the power of the Ontario Municipal Board to dismiss an appeal
